INSTRUCTIONS

01

Follow the instructions on the reverse of this leaflet to take your sample.

02

Check the label on your vials has your correct name & date of birth on it. Place into the protective packaging.

03

After adding the time and date on the lab form, place the form and the sample in the envelope provided.

04

Post your sample on the day you take it. Do not post on a Friday. We strongly recommend sending Special Delivery

Included in your package

- ✓ Vials for Blood collection
- ✓ Lancets,
- ✓ Wipes, Plasters
- ✓ Return Envelope
- ✓ Lab form

01

Lay out everything you need before you start.
Make sure you are well hydrated

Place sample tubes in front of you. Do not mix up the coloured caps
Draw blood for purple vial first then yellow (if using two vials)



02

Wash your hands in warm water
Select a finger and use the alcohol wipe to clean it. Dry your finger

Twist the end off the first lancet. Don't worry, you won't see a needle.
Hold firmly against the side of your chosen finger and press down on the top of the lancet. Wipe away the first drop of blood..



Massage the side of your finger to form drops of blood.

03

Hold your finger against the collection tube,
let the drops of blood slide in



If the blood stops flowing simply use a new lancet to prick the same or another finger.
Do not force the blood it can damage the cells.



04

Fill each tube to the upper line marked on the side of the tube do not under or overfill. Apply plasters provided

Push the cap firmly on the top of each tube remembering to place the correct cap on each one.



05

Flip the tube 10 times forward and backward.
Do not shake.

Check the label on your vial is correct
Turnaround is usually 1-2 working days from arriving at the lab. Results will be uploaded to your account.
